### From Casa to College

Casa to College bridges the gap between [Neighborhood Name] and a college education.

Each week, nearly 20 teens come for academic support, college guidance, and leadership development. Depending on the week, students may visit a college campus, learn to write their resume, or discuss career options.

Casa to College helps students to

- Overcome academic obstacles to earn their high-school degree
- Research and apply for college

Securing a high-school and college degree opens to the door to economic opportunities. With a strong graduation rate, Casa to College has a demonstrated history of success in preparing students to finish high school, transition to college, and pursue their future.

#### The Current Need

Right now, there are no Casa to College slots available for new students. Attendance doubled in the 2022-2023 school year, and we expect that demand will continue to soar.

To meet current demand and to scale the program, we will need to increase our staff support from 1 full-time staff member with part-time support to 3 full-time staff members.

These hires will increase program capacity by nearly 50%, and allow more students to have equal opportunities to succeed in high school and beyond.
